

## **DAY THREE**

### **Who is Worship for?**

**PRAYER** – Lord will you help me to see who worship is really for? I don't want to go through the motions of something that is not focused on You. I love you Lord and I give You all my worship. In Jesus Name, Amen.

**WORD** – Read Psalm 145:1-3. *“I lift you high in praise, my God my King! And I'll bless your name into eternity. I bless you every day, and keep it up from now to eternity. God is magnificent: He can never be praised enough.” (Message)*

A lot of the things we do in church or even in our Christian life are for us or other people. Much of Christianity is performance oriented. We do things because we want approval or acceptance. We do things because we think those things are expected of us by the group. To some people worship is performing or singing to a congregation. One guy said that worship is for an audience of One. Worship is for God alone. It is in worship that we tell Him that we love Him. If you are in a relationship with someone you don't let others tell that person how you feel about them. You tell them. You love them. Worship is for God and it is for you to tell Him that you love Him. No one can do that for you. Who is worship for? God.

**CHALLENGE** - Take a piece of paper and write out the reasons that you love God. You might want to include the things He has done for you. Write it like God is the person you adore most. Write it out like you are going to give Him paper. Take a minute and read your paper out loud to God.
